Skills, experience and qualities needed.

When and Where

We are piloting a new scheme designed to modernize the workplace ethic and how we work. It is requested you work from home and pick your own hours. Though this is an unpaid post, once funding will allow, we will offer a monthly wage with no set hours.

What you could get out of it

We currently cannot offer training. However, by volunteering, you will gain valuable experience, develop your skills. We also offer a reference for employer, college or universities on request.

If you have a course that requires work experience, we can provide the educator with a detailed report to support your certificate. Please contact your educational provider about any awards, certificates and scoring that you may be entitled to. We can provide certificates or local awards to recognise the contribution volunteers make, which can support third party education or employment.
